# First Reading ROMANS 6:1B-11

A reading from Romans.

<sup>1b</sup>Should we continue in sin in order that grace may abound? <sup>2</sup>By no means! How can we who died to sin go on living in it? <sup>3</sup>Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup>Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

<sup>5</sup>For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. <sup>6</sup>We know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to sin. <sup>7</sup>For whoever has died is freed from sin. <sup>8</sup>But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. <sup>9</sup>We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. <sup>10</sup>The death he died, he died to sin, once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. <sup>11</sup>So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

# Gospel Matthew 10:24-39

P The holy gospel according to St. Matthew.

C Glory to you, O Lord.

**Jesus:** <sup>24</sup> A student is no greater than his teacher, and a servant is never greater than his master. <sup>25</sup> It is sufficient if the student is like his teacher and the servant like his master. If people call the head of a house "Beelzebul," which means "devil," just imagine what they're calling the members of his household.

<sup>26</sup> Do not be afraid of those who may taunt or persecute you. Everything they do—even if they think they are hiding behind closed doors—will come to light. All their secrets will eventually be made known. <sup>27</sup> And you should proclaim in the bright light of day everything that I have whispered to you in the dark. Whatever whispers you hear—shout them from the rooftops of houses.

<sup>28</sup> Don't fear those who *aim to* kill just the body but are unable to touch the soul. The One to fear is He who can destroy you, soul and body, in the fires of hell. <sup>29</sup> Look, if you sold a few sparrows, *how much money would you get*? A copper coin apiece, perhaps? And yet your Father in heaven knows when those small sparrows fall to the ground. <sup>30-31</sup> You, beloved, are worth so much

more than a whole flock of sparrows. God knows *everything about* you, even the number of hairs on your head. So do not fear.

<sup>32</sup> Whoever knows Me here on earth, I will know him in heaven. And whoever proclaims faith in Me here on earth, I will proclaim faith in him before My Father in heaven. <sup>33</sup> But whoever disowns Me here, I will disown before My Father in heaven.

<sup>34</sup> Do not imagine that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. <sup>35</sup> I have come to turn men against their fathers, daughters against their mothers, and daughters-in-law against their mothers-in-law. <sup>36</sup> You will find you have enemies even in your own household. <sup>37</sup> If you love your father or mother more than you love Me, then you are not worthy of Me. If you love your son or daughter more than you love Me, then you are not worthy of Me. <sup>38</sup> If you refuse to take up your cross and follow Me on the narrow road, then you are not worthy of Me. <sup>39</sup> To find your life, you must lose your life—and whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.
